

## Whirl Prayer Catcher

Cut out the Prayer Catcher from the following page, then follow the instructions or look up a video online to learn how to fold it and use it to pray with each other.

### Making the Prayer Catcher







1. Cut out the square along the black line.
2. Lay it face-up on a flat surface.
3. Fold the square in half from left to right, then open it up and fold it in half from top to bottom.
4. Open up the square and flip it over.
5. Fold each corner to the middle of the square, making a smaller square.
6. Flip over the square, keeping the corners folded in.
7. Fold the corners in again, making an even smaller square.
8. Keeping all folds intact, fold the square in half from left to right, then open it and fold it in half again from top to bottom.
9. Pick it up and put your thumbs and index fingers under each corner flap, puffing them out to create a diamond-shaped movable prayer catcher.

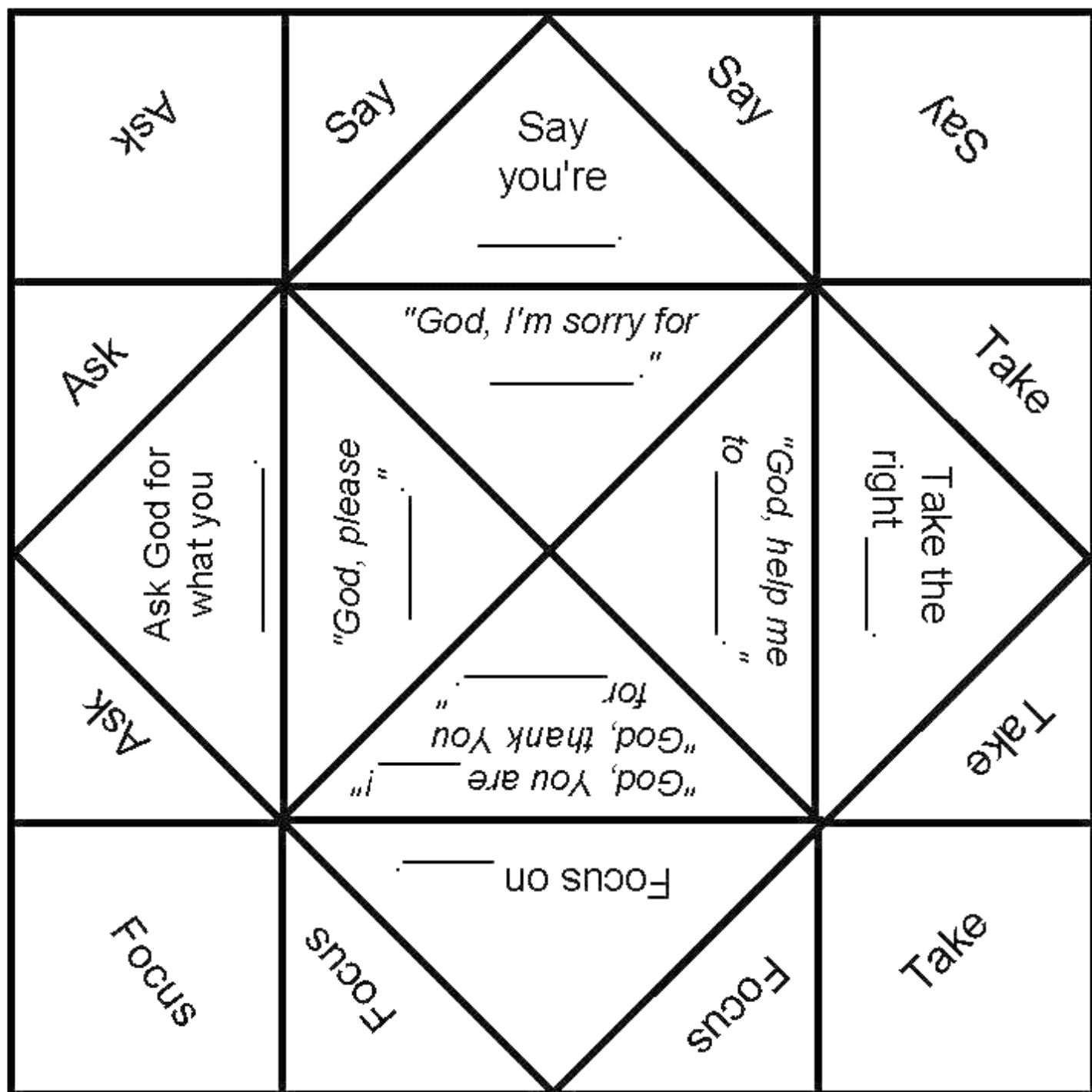
### Using the Prayer Catcher

1. Choose one of the characters—Ada, Otto, Mimi, or Leo. Open and close the Prayer Catcher as you say each letter of the character's name.
2. Look inside the Prayer Catcher and choose another character. Open and close the Prayer Catcher as you say each letter of the character's name.
3. Look inside the Prayer Catcher and choose one more character. Open the flap to look under that character, and say the prayer written there.
4. Repeat as desired.

1. Cut out the square along the outside lines.
2. Fold the square in half to form a triangle, and then fold that triangle in half to form a smaller triangle.
3. Unfold the triangles back to the original square.
4. Lay the square down with the lines facing down.
5. Fold the corners of the square to the center.
6. Keep them folded, and then turn the square over.
7. Fold the corners of the square to the center (as you did on the other side).
8. Fold and unfold the bottom half of the square to the top.
9. Fold and unfold the left half of the square to the right.
10. Place your thumbs and forefingers inside the flaps of the exposed squares and pinch the folded tips of each square together so that they all meet in the center.
